**Last Meetings speaker**, Michael James was introduced by Bernard Kendall. Michael spoke about the problems of building cladding fires on high rise buildings that have been built with cladding constructed of polystyrene layer sandwiched between 2 thin sheets of Aluminium. Polystyrene burns/melts like petrol & droplets splashes onto the building resulting in fires similar to the Grenfell Building in UK. Experts all over the world are looking for a solution to this problem. NZ is fortunate in that it does not have many high rise buildings.
