2 March 2020

President Derek welcomed members John Clements a visiting Rotarian from the Poole, UK; Barry—Maurice Wakefield's guest; Shefali Mehta and our Speaker Barney Irvine.

He also thanked the club for a successful Top Schools day and requested that we acknowledged the work that Peter Allen and Owen Williams undertook to ensure the day ran smoothly.

Ian Willetts advised that there will be 22 teams attending MUNA this year and will be seeking volunteers to help out.



Barney Irvine from AA addressed the club on his organisation's work regarding Auckland Transport issues.

They have a very big membership base 2/3 people belong to the AA. The number of members in Auckland personal & corporate totals 500,000. The AA are actively tracking commuter travel times by utilising data gathered by Google/Uber Drivers etc. They have found that in the last 2 years travel time has levelled out to 79-85 hours per year motorway travelling. There is also a direct co-relation to the increase in vehicle ownership per capita and the spreading out of Auckland suburbs. This data is used to lobby both regional and national governing bodies to get the correct projects /solutions put in place. At present it appears that the "bigger picture" is not being taken into account and some project should have being delayed until other projects were finished—i.e. the flood/cycleway project on Tamaki Drive while the CRL project is taking place.

There should be other measures used in conjunction with big projects like smart traffic lights/ variable medium barriers / education of commuters to travel/work at different times or better off-site working environments. This presentation demonstrated that there are no simple quick fix to these issues.
